**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34 OF CHAPTER 4,
OF THE OLYMPIA FIELDS VILLAGE CODE, "RESTRICTIONS ON ISSUANCE"**

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-12

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OLYMPIA FIELDS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Section 4-34 of the Olympia Fields Village Code is hereby amended to provide as follows: [New language **bold faced**]:

Sec. 4-34. - Restrictions on issuance.

A. No village retailer's license of any kind shall be issued:

- (1) To a person, partnership, or corporation declared ineligible for a license under section 6-1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, as amended [235 ILCS 5/6-2], or to a person, partnership, or corporation not eligible for a state retail liquor dealer's license.
- (2) For use on premises adjacent to churches, schools, hospitals, or other institutions or place of business if issuance of such license would be contrary to sections 6-11, 6-12 or 6-15 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, as amended [235 ILCS 5/6-11, 6-12, or 6-15].
- (3) For premises to be licensed under a restaurant, hotel, club, or bowling alley classification unless such premises shall fully qualify under the definitions of such places as given in article I of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, as amended [235 ILCS 5/1-1], and in regard to a restaurant, that the premises shall qualify as a restaurant under section 4-1.

B. **No new liquor license will be issued and no renewal license will be issued unless:**

- (1) **any applicant who is a tenant submits an "Owner's Certification" form verifying that the liquor licensee has a valid lease for the licensed premises.**
- (2) **any applicant who owns the property where the applicant liquor licensee business is located shows proof of ownership of the property.**
- (3) **the applicant furnishes the Village with proof the applicant has obtained liquor liability insurance as required by 235 ILCS 5/6-2(18).**

Section 2: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
